Honor Roll and Other Honors

Parents/Guardians:

The following information is located on page eight (8) of the Hawthorn Student Handbook.

Hawthorn Middle School Honor Rolls:

At the middle school level, a student's grade point average (GPA) is calculated with the issuance of each trimester report card and based on **ALL** class grades. Recognition is given for High Honor Roll (3.5 to 4.0 GPA), Honor Roll (3.0 to 3.49) and Improvement Honor Roll (for GPA improvement of .5 or better).

* If a student earns any letter grade lower than "C", the student is not eligible for Honor Roll.

Other Awards:

Presidential Education Award: Eighth Grade students who have earned a 4.0 cumulative grade point average in seventh and eighth grade (4.0 in ALL Classes) are eligible for this award. Students will be recognized at the Eighth Grade Awards Ceremony and receive a certificate, medallion and honor cord.

* GPA is calculated up to the award ceremony.

Hawthorn Academic Award: Eighth Grade students who have earned a 3.5 or better cumulative grade point average in seventh grade and the first two trimesters of the eighth grade (without having a grade lower than a "C") are eligible for this award. Students will be recognized at the Eighth Grade Awards Ceremony and receive a certificate and medallion.

Hawthorn Eagle Awards: Each teacher and/or department may select students from his/her classes to receive this award in recognition of outstanding effort and/or achievement in a particular class. These awards are presented periodically throughout the academic year.

End of the Year: Numerous other awards are presented at the end of the year at the spring awards assemblies (6th and 7th grade awards are held during the day with their team).

Eighth Grade Awards Ceremony: This year, the Eighth Grade Awards Ceremony will be held on: May 29, 2018, 10:00 AM, at Hawthorn Middle School North. Students receiving the Presidential Award, Hawthorn Academic Award and recognition in band, chorus, related arts, visual art, athletics, yearbook, student council and bilingual literacy will be honored. Student's receiving awards will be sent an invitation in the beginning of May 2018.
